

ORDINANCE NO. - 80

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A PETTY CASH FUND FOR  
THE SPENCER MAYOR'S COURT IN ORDER TO MAKE CHANGE  
TO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of  
Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring  
herein as follows:

1. There is hereby established a petty cash fund  
of \$50.00 which shall be kept by the Mayor of Spencer  
and be under his control and direction in the Spencer  
Mayor's Court for the purpose of making change to  
members of the public paying fines and court costs  
in said court. This fund shall be a continuing fund  
until further order of this Council.

2. The petty cash fund created by this Ordinance  
shall be paid from the General Fund of the Village.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health,  
and safety of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the  
particular reason that this petty cash fund is immediately  
necessary to foster the proper operation of the Spencer  
Mayor's Court, and that this Ordinance shall be in full  
force and effect from and after its passage.
