

AN ORDINANCE TO AFFIRM THE CONTINUED
EXISTENCE OF VILLAGE ORDINANCES NOS.
80 AND 81 AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Village Council that by Ordinance No. 245 previously passed on July 27, 1972 repealing certain old and obsolescent ordinances from the Village records, there may have been a misunderstanding so that it is unclear whether or not Ordinance 80 passed May 22, 1945 establishing the Board of Public Affairs and Ordinance No. 81 also passed on May 22, 1945 merging the duties of the Clerk of the Board and the Clerk of the Village have been repealed; and

WHEREAS, it was not the intention of the Village Council in passing Ordinance No. 245 to repeal Ordinance Nos. 80 and 81;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. That Ordinance No. 245 previously passed by the Spencer Village Council on July 27, 1972 is hereby clarified and interpreted as not repealing Ordinance No. 80 and Ordinance No. 81 passed by the Spencer Village Council on May 22, 1945 and that said Ordinance No. 80 and Ordinance No. 81 are hereby affirmed as being in full force and effect continuously from their passage on May 22, 1945 through current date.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the particular reason that it is necessary to clarify the status of Ordinance Nos. 80 and 81 to provide for the continued operation of the Spencer Board of Public Affairs and the combined offices of the Clerk of the Board and the Village Clerk-Treasur, and that this Ordinance shall be in

full force and effect from and after its passage.
