

ORDINANCE NO. 10 - 80

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED LEASE
OF PART OF FIRESTONE PARK LAND TO FLOYD J.
HIRSCHMAN AND DOROTHY HIRSCHMAN TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of
Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring
herein, as follows:

1. That the existing lease between the Village of
Spencer and Floyd J. Hirschman and Dorothy Hirschman
shall be extended for a period of one year to March 1,
1982 at 12:00 Noon under the same terms and conditions
set forth in the original written lease between said
parties and pertaining to the Village land currently
being farmed by said Floyd J. Hirschman. However, the
rental amount for the additional years term is hereby
increased to \$50.00 per acre.

2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of
Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is
in the interest of the Village of Spencer to have the
cultivated field limed and fertilized in accordance with
the terms of the original lease and on account of the
coming winter season there is not time to solicit bids
for renting such farm land and still have the land limed
and fertilized as required. Therefore, this ordinance

shall be in full force and effect from and after its
passage.
