

ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 81

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO IN PARTICULAR
SECTION 71.26 REGARDING THE PENALTY FOR PHYSICAL
CONTROL OF A VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE
OF ALCOHOL OR DRUG ABUSE AND TO DECLARE AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of
Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring
herein, as follows:

1. Section 71.26 of the Code of Ordinances of the
Village of Spencer is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 71.26 IN POSSESSION WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE

No person who is under the influence of alcohol or any
drug abuse, or the combined influence of alcohol or any drug
abuse, shall be in actual physical control of any vehicle
within the Village of Spencer, Ohio. Any person who violates
this Section shall be fined not more than \$500.00."

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer and
for the particular reason that this amendment to the Village
Code of Ordinances is necessary to assist the police in
controlling traffic and preserving the peace and that this
Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage.
