

ORDINANCE NO. 6 -81

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SQUEALING OF TIRES
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO PROVIDING A
PENALTY THEREFOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Spencer Village Council that a problem exists within Spencer Village with regard to the squealing of tires; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety, street maintenance and the general preservation of the public peace, it is necessary to alleviate the problem of squealing tires in the Village of Spencer;

NOW THEREFOR, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. Except when required in an emergency situation, no person within the Village of Spencer shall cause the tires of any motor vehicle to squeal by means of braking, turning or acceleration in a manner that can be heard 20 feet distant from the point where such tire squealing takes place or in such manner as to leave tire marks upon the pavement.

2. Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$50.00.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the particular reason that this Ordinance is immediately necessary to preserve

the safety of users of the public streets and good order within the Village of Spencer and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
