

ORDINANCE NO. 13 81

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 92.07 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF PSENCER, OHIO TO PROHIBIT THE SALE TO OR FURNISHING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR BEER TO UNDER AGED PERSONS, TO PROVIDE A PENALTY THEREFORE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. Section 92.07 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Spencer, Ohio is hereby amended by adding the following sub section thereto:

(H) No person shall sell intoxicating liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one years or sell beer to a person under the age of eighteen, or buy intoxicating liquor for, or furnish it to, a person under the age of twenty-one years, or buy beer for or furnish it to a person under the age of eighteen, unless given by a physician in the regular line of his practice, or by a parent or legal guardian. Whoever violates Section 92.07 (H) of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Spencer, is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to bring the Village Code of Ordinances in line with the Ohio Revised Code concerning the prohibition against sale to or furnishing to persons under age, intoxicating liquor or beer, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
