

ORDINANCE 2- 84

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOWEST AND BEST
BID FOR INSURANCE COVERAGE, AUTHORIZING AND
DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF INSURANCE
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer,
Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein as follows:


1. That the bid of Lance & Co., of Medina, Ohio

is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid for insurance
coverage for the Village of Spencer and is hereby accepted.

2. That the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and
directed to enter into and to execute any necessary forms or
contracts to place such insurance in full force and effect.

3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public
peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer,
Ohio and for the particular reason that the current insurance
coverage of the Village of Spencer expires as of February 1, 1984
and it is immediately necessary to enter into new insurance
coverage so that no insurance gap will exist when the present
coverage expires, and that this ordinance shall be in full force
and effect from and after its passage.
