

ORDINANCE NO. / -84

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE SERVING OR CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR, BEER OR WINE BY ANY PERSON UNDER THE LEGAL AGE IN ANY ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER LICENSED BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. As used in this Ordinance the terms liquor, beer and wine shall have the same definitions as those terms are now or in the future defined in Section 4301.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.
2. As used in this Ordinance, legal age shall be twenty-one years (21) with regard to the serving or consumption of liquor and wine and nineteen years (19) with regard to the serving or consumption of beer.
3. No person in any establishment or public place in the Village of Spencer, Ohio licensed by the Ohio Department of Liquor Control shall serve, give or allow to be consumed liquor, wine or beer to any person under the legal age for purchase and consumption of liquor, wine or beer.
4. No person in any establishment or public place in the Village of Spencer, Ohio licensed by the Ohio Department of Liquor Control who is under the legal age shall consume liquor, beer or wine.

5. Whoever violates any Section of this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$50.00.


6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is necessary to immediately correct an abuse of allowing consumption of liquor, beer and wine by persons under legal age in licensed establishments in the Village of Spencer, Ohio and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
