

ORDINANCE NO / -86

AN ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY APPROPRIATE TWENTY THOUSAND
AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$20,000.00) FOR EXPENDITURES FROM
THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER GENERAL FUND IN 1986 UNTIL THE
PERMANENT APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE IS PASSED AND TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio,
three-fourths of its members herein concurring, as follows:


1. The sum of Twenty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$20,000.00)
is hereby appropriated as a temporary measure for expenditures from
the general fund of the Village of Spencer, Ohio during the early part
of 1986 prior to the passage of the permanent appropriation ordinance
of the Village of Spencer for the year 1986.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and
welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason
that a temporary appropriation ordinance is necessary in order to
maintain the usual public services of the Village until such time as a
permanent appropriation ordinance for the year 1986 is passed and that
this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
passage.
