

ORDINANCE NO. 15-87

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PLACING OF GRASS
CUTTINGS, LEAVES OR OTHER FOREIGN MATERIALS IN
THE STREETS RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND TO DECLARE AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio that the storm drainage system of the Village is being interfered with and damaged due to the placing of grass cuttings, leaves or other foreign materials in the tree lawns and street gutters which on occasion plug the storm sewers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. No person shall place grass cuttings, leaves or other foreign materials in any dedicated street right-of-way of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, other than materials left for normal trash pick up and the mulching and fertilization of trees in the tree lawns.


2. Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety and

welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that proper maintenance and continued operation of the municipal storm drainage system requires the immediate passage of this Ordinance and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
