

ORDINANCE NO. 16-87


AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID  
FOR THE REFINISHING OF TENNIS AND BASKETBALL  
COURTS AT THE JOHN B. FIRESTONE MEMORIAL PARK  
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer,  
Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as  
follows:


1. The bid of Continental Coatings, 2844 Batdorf Road,  
Wooster, Ohio 44691 in the amount of Five Thousand Five Hundred  
Eighty-Two and no/100 Dollars (\$5,582.00) for the refinishing  
of the tennis and basketball courts at the John B. Firestone  
Memorial Park, Spencer, Ohio in accordance with the plans and  
specifications thereof and the legal advertisement therefore  
is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted.
2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and  
directed to enter into a contract for such refinishing work  
with the successful bidder in a contract form approved by the  
Spencer Village Solicitor.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to pay  
the bid amount to the successful bidder as per the service  
contract and such expenditures shall be charged to the  
Village General Fund and/or the Firestone Fund.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is necessary to act immediately in order to preserve the bid price for the refinishing work, and that this Ordinance shall take affect and be in full force from and after its passage.
