

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -87

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID  
FOR A POLICE CRUISER AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. The bid of Ganley Dodge West, 15600 Lorain Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44111 in the amount of Twelve Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Eight and no/100 Dollars (\$12,198.00) for the police cruiser in accordance with the Village specifications for same is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted.

2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement for said police cruiser with the successful bidder in the usual form for such transactions as approved by the Village Solicitor.

3. The Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to pay the bid amount to the successful bidder as per the sales contract and such expenditures shall be charged to the Safety Fund and/or the Firestone Fund.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular

reason that it is necessary to act immediately in order to preserve the bid price for the police cruiser which is necessary for the proper operation of the Spencer Village Police Department, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
