

ORDINANCE 20-87

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON SCHOOL LANE  
DURING SCHOOL HOURS, TO ASSESS A PENALTY FOR  
VIOLATION THEREOF AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer,  
Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein,  
as follows:

1. Parking on School Lane <sup>and Washington Street from its west end to a point adjacent to the east boundary of school property</sup> within the Village of Spencer, Ohio during the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 2:30 P.M. while school is in session is hereby prohibited.
2. Appropriate no parking signs shall be erected on School Lane under the supervision of the Spencer Village Police Department.
3. Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be assessed a fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each violation.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to have no parking during school hours on School Lane so as

preserve the safety of the children attending said school and to have orderly traffic on School Lane, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
