

ORDINANCE NO. 17-87

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID OF K&M CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR IMPROVEMENT OF NORTH MAIN STREET, TO AUTHORIZE ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT FOR SUCH IMPROVEMENT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. That the bid of K&M Construction Company in the amount of Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Ninety Eight and no/100 Dollars (\$19,598.00) for the improvement of North Main Street in accordance with the plans and specifications for such improvement prepared by the Village Engineer is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted.

2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the successful bidder for such street improvement by a form approved by the Village Solicitor.

3. The contract price shall be paid from the Firestone Fund.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer and

for the particular reason that it is necessary to immediately enter into this contract in order to preserve the low bid price, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
