

ORDINANCE NO. 7-87

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SPENCER VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO ABANDON THE PROCEEDINGS SET FORTH IN THE SPENCER VILLAGE COMPLAINT FOR APPROPRIATION AGAINST ERNEST H. KNAPP, JR., ET AL., CASE NO. 47000, 86 CIV 0705 AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. The Spencer Village Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to file a motion in the Medina County Court of Common Pleas, Case No. 47000, 86 CIV 0705, Village of Spencer, Ohio, Plaintiff v. Ernest H. Knapp, Jr., et al., defendants to abandon said proceedings under the authority of Ohio Revised Code 163.21.

2. All costs, fees and expenses legally required of the Village of Spencer, Ohio in the abandonment of said proceedings should be paid out of the East Main Street Improvement Fund.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that abandonment of said appropriation proceedings will enable the Village to proceed with the first phase of the East Main Street project without delay and further expense, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
