

ORDINANCE NO. 13-89

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR DISPATCH SERVICES WITH THE MEDINA COUNTY SHERIFF, TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENT FOR SAME AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. The agreement for dispatch services between the Village of Spencer and the Medina County Sheriff which has been thoroughly reviewed by the Council of the Village of Spencer and is incorporated herein by reference is hereby approved for a period of one (1) year commencing January 1, 1990 and the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the Village of Spencer.
2. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to pay the required monthly payments for such dispatch services called for by the agreement and to charge the appropriate fund therefor.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that the current dispatch service contract expires at the end of the year and the new dispatch service contract is immediately necessary for adequate police

and safety requirements of the Village of Spencer and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
