

Ordinance No. 9 -89

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE FORMULA RECOMMENDED
BY THE MEDINA COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION FOR
APPORTIONMENT OF THE COUNTY UNDIVIDED LOCAL
GOVERNMENT REVENUE ASSISTANCE FUND AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer,
Ohio, three fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein,
as follows:

1. The formula recommended by the Medina County Budget
Commission for the apportionment of the County undivided local
government revenue assistance fund, which is the same formula
now used for apportionment of the local government fund, and
as set forth in the letter dated September 12, 1988 from
Ferris W. Brown, Secretary of the Medina County Budget
Commission, a copy of said letter being attached hereto and
made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the protection of the public peace,
health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and
for the immediate reason that approval of this measure is
required within a limited statutory period so that immediate
action is necessary and that this Ordinance shall be in full
force and effect from and after its passage.

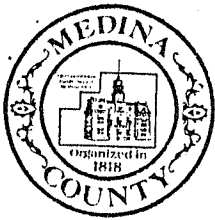

The Medina County Budget Commission has adopted the apportionment as shown below for your 1989 Estimated County Undivided Local Government Revenue Assistance Fund.

The apportionment is based upon a 1984 agreed to local government formula which is as follows:

1983 Actual Receipts (your local government)	+	Population Factor (% x (1989) county- wide estimate minus 1983 county-wide receipts)	=	1989 Estimate (your local government)

Any amounts received in excess of the annual estimate will be distributed on the same basis.

As part of House Bill 171 the Ohio legislature changed the percentages of the sources that make up the local government fund and added two new tax sources, public utility and use taxes while at the same time created the Local Government Revenue Assistance Fund (LGRAF). The purpose of this fund is to provide additional unrestricted assistance to local governments from state-shared tax revenue. The fund comes into existence on July 1, 1989, with the first distribution due in July of 1989. It is to be distributed to the counties on a straight per capita basis.

Continued growth in our local government fund is being projected by the legislative budget office through the last year surveyed, which was 1997.
