

ORDINANCE NO. 12-91

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR A NEW VILLAGE POLICE CRUISER, TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF SAID POLICE CRUISER AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO, three fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. The bid of Mathews Ford Wooster, Inc., 4199 Cleveland Road, P.O. Box 538, Wooster, Ohio 44691 in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Two (\$15,762.00) Dollars for sale to the Village of a new police cruiser is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted by the Village of Spencer.


2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement contract with said successful bidder for the purchase of said police cruiser.

3. The purchase price of the new police cruiser shall be charged to the General Fund and/or the Firestone Fund by the Village Clerk and the amount thereof is hereby appropriated.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that it is necessary to immediately enter into a purchase agreement with the successful bidder in


order to obtain the police cruiser at the bid price and that
