

ORDINANCE NO. 9-91

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE RURAL LORAIN COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AN EIGHT INCH (8) PIPE LINE TO THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER FOR THE PERMANENT WATER SUPPLY OF THE VILLAGE, TO DIRECT THE MAYOR AND CLERK TO SIGN SAID CONTRACT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Spencer has determined that due to the condition of its water facilities, the Ohio EPA and other factors, including the cost of the required upgrading of its present system, it is necessary and practical to purchase treated water from the Rural Lorain County Water Authority, hereafter referred to as "RLCWA"; and

WHEREAS, RLCWA owns and operates a water supply distribution system with a capacity capable of serving the present and future needs of the Village of Spencer and is willing to supply the Village with its water needs; and

WHEREAS, RLCWA proposes to construct an eight inch (8) PVC water line from State Route 18 to the North boundary of the Village of Spencer on the condition that the Village of Spencer will pay for the construction of said water line; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Spencer has determined that it is reasonable, prudent and practical to pay for the cost of construction of this water line;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, OHIO, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. That the proposed agreement between the Village of Spencer and RLCWA whereby RLCWA will construct an eight inch (8) PVC water line from State Route 18 to the North line of Spencer Village as well as construct a pump station at State Route 18 and a water meter vault adjacent to the Village North Corporate limit for an estimated project cost of Two Hundred Eighty Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$285,000.00) which the Village will deposit with RLCWA upon the obtaining of bids to be approved by the Village of Spencer, which proposed contract form has been approved by the Spencer Village Solicitor, and which contract proposal is incorporated herein by a reference, be and the same is hereby approved.

2. The estimated project cost of Two Hundred Eighty Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$285,000.00) is hereby appropriated by the Village of Spencer to be paid from the appropriate funds of the Village.

3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract with RLCWA and deliver the fully signed contract to said water authority.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio for the particular reason that it is necessary to immediately enter into this contract so as to assure the prompt construction of this

water line and thus insure a continued public water supply for
Spencer Village which water supply otherwise would be in
jeopardy, and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in
full force from and after its passage.
