AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE  
KEEPING OF ANIMALS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer,  
Medina County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members  
concurring herein as follows:

1. No person shall keep any reptile, domestic animal  
pig, horse, cow, goat, no more than three (3) cats, no more than  
three (3) dogs over three (3) months of age, or any other animal  
or animals or any fowl or poultry in any pen, yard, lot, or other  
enclosure situated within one hundred (100') of an inhabited  
dwelling house other than the house of the owner of such animals,  
fowl or poultry.

2. The owner or keeper of any such animal or animals,  
fowl, poultry or reptile shall keep the pen, yard, lot or other  
enclosures in a sanitary condition and free from preventable  
offensive odors.

3. Any section of the Spencer Village Ordinances in  
conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

4. Whoever violates any provision of this Ordinance  
shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00):  
a violation of this Ordinance shall be considered a minor  
misdemeanor.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,  
health, safety and welfare, and for the particular reason  
that said Ordinance provides for resolution of an immediate  
problem with the keeping of animals within Village limits,

said Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.
