

ORDINANCE NO. 3-97

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE USE OF TRASH  
RECEPTACLES AND KEEPING OF SUCH  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Spencer Village Council, three-fourths  
(3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:


1) The owner, agent, lessee, or occupant of any dwelling unit, restaurant, cafe, grocery, store or market where refuse is produced or permitted to accumulate shall provide an adequate number of containers, of adequate size, for such refuse. All refuse shall be contained in such containers. Each container shall be maintained at all times in a safe and sanitary condition.

2) No person shall place or maintain any receptacle for refuse so that it will constitute a nuisance.


3) Whoever violates any provision of this ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor, and shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), per <sup>VIOLATION</sup> instance.

4) This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the particular reason that refuse is being kept in unsafe and unsanitary conditions, and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
