

ORDINANCE NO. 11 -97

**AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT THE LIBERTY
STREET AND RAINBOW STREET IMPROVEMENTS,
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS FOR SAME, SHOULD
BE MADE, ACCEPTING THE LOWEST AND BEST BID
FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH
THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT,
AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THE CONTRACT PRICE
FROM THE APPROPRIATE FUND AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. That the Liberty Street and Rainbow Street improvements, in accordance with the plans, should be made;


2. That the bid of Hinckley and Lutes Excavating and Paving Inc., 713 S.R. 18 East, Norwalk, Ohio 44857, in the amount of Five Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-two and 50/100 Dollars (\$576,352.50) is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted by the Village of Spencer.

3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the successful bidder on a contract form approved by the Village Solicitor.

4. The contract price is hereby appropriated and shall be paid from the Firestone Fund and the appropriate street improvement funds of the Village of Spencer in accordance with said contract.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to accept such bid and enter into a contract with a successful bidder in order to take advantage of the best and lowest bid and to commence work on the Liberty Street and Rainbow Street improvements as soon as practical in the current building season, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
