
**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLACEMENT
OF STOP SIGNS ON JACKSON AND LORAIN STREETS**

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is necessary to stop traffic at the intersection of Jackson and Lorain Streets within the territorial limits of the Village of Spencer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. A stop sign shall be placed on the southeast corner and northwest corner of Jackson Street at the intersection of Jackson and Lorain Streets thereby stopping northbound and southbound traffic on Jackson Street.
2. A stop sign shall be placed on the northeast corner of Lorain Street thereby stopping westbound traffic at the intersection of Jackson and Lorain Streets.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Spencer and for the particular reason that traffic flow on Jackson Street and Lorain Street needs to be stopped at the intersection of the two streets; this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
