

ORDINANCE NO. 11-98

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF AUXILIARY ENGINE BRAKES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

Section 1. No person shall drive or operate any motor vehicle within Spencer Village limits which is equipped with special engine or auxiliary engine brakes or "jake brakes" in such a manner that the use of said brakes is likely to cause inconvenience or annoyance to persons of ordinary sensibilities.


Section 2. Whoever violates any section of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section 3. All other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the particular reason that this regulation is necessary to prohibit the use of auxiliary engine brakes that are likely to cause annoyance to


persons living within Spencer Village limits; this Ordinance is hereby in full force and effect from and after its passage.
