

ORDINANCE NO. 1-98


AN ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR EXPENDITURES IN 1998, UNTIL THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE IS PASSED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members herein concurring as follows:

1. The sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund, Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000) from the Firestone Trust Fund, Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) from the Street Fund, Three Thousand Five Hundred (\$3,500) from the Police Levy Fund, Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000) from the Sewer Fund, and Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) from the Water Fund, as a temporary measure for expenditures for the Village of Spencer, Ohio, during the early part of 1998, prior to the passage of the permanent appropriation ordinance of the Village of Spencer for the year 1998.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio and for the particular reason that a temporary appropriation ordinance is necessary in order to maintain the usual public services of the Village until such time as a permanent appropriation for the year 1998 is passed and that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
