

ORDINANCE NO. 12-98

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TREE LAWNS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring
herein as follows:

Section 1. No person shall park a motor vehicle of any
kind on tree lawns within the Village of Spencer.


Section 2. Whoever violates any section of this
Ordinance shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars
(\$100.00).

Section 3. All other ordinances or sections of
ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the particular reason
that this regulation is necessary to prevent hazards presented by
the parking of motor vehicles on tree lawns along streets within


the Village of Spencer; this Ordinance is in full force and effect from and after its passage.
