

ORDINANCE NO. 3-99

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING APPLICATION
FOR CURB CUTS WITHIN SPENCER VILLAGE LIMITS**

WHEREAS, it is necessary to regulate the cutting of any opening of any curbs within the Village of Spencer;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:


A. Any person, firm, or corporation which desires to cut an opening in any curb for the purpose of facilitating ingress or egress or for any other purpose or desires to make a street opening in any streets shall file an application with the Village Clerk on forms provided by the Village Clerk stating all dimensions required, the specific location and purpose of the cut, and stating the date that such work is to be done.

B. Any person, firm, or corporation who does not apply for the required application shall be billed double the cost of the application fee amounting to a sum of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00).

C. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of said Village and for the particular reason that the Village of Spencer needs to

regulate the cutting of any opening in any curb within Spencer
Village limits.
