

ORDINANCE NO. 15-01

**AN ORDINANCE BANNING THE PARKING OF
MOTOR VEHICLES ON WASHINGTON STREET
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

It is hereby established that there shall be no parking of any motor vehicle on either side of Washington Street in the Village of Spencer.


Whoever violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense, and not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for any additional offenses within a one (1) year period.

All Ordinances previously enacted that are determined to be in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, and for the particular reason that there are current abuses of parking on Washington Street which


must be immediately controlled, and that this Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
