

ORDINANCE NO. 16-01


**AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT THE SALT
BIN IMPROVEMENT SHOULD BE COMPLETED
ACCEPTING THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR
SAID IMPROVEMENT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
AND CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH
THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT,
AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THE CONTRACT
PRICE FROM THE APPROPRIATE FUND, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. That construction of the salt bin improvement in accordance with acceptable plans should be completed.
2. That the bid of Teresko Construction, Inc. in the amount of Twenty-five Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$25,450.00) is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted by the Village of Spencer.
3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the successful bidder on a contract form approved by the Village Solicitor.
4. The contract price is hereby appropriated and shall be paid from the Firestone Trust Fund in accordance with said contract.
5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,


health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to accept such bid and enter into a contract with the successful bidder so as to commence work on this improvement as soon as is practical during the current building season, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
