

**ORDINANCE NO. 19-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SALARY AND/OR  
WAGES OF THE CLERK/TREASURER OF THE  
VILLAGE OF SPENCER AND THE CLERK/  
TREASURER OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC  
AFFAIRS AND ADDING A SALARY AND/OR  
WAGE FOR AN ASSISTANT TO THE CLERK/  
TREASURER OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER  
AND AN ASSISTANT TO THE CLERK/TREASURER  
OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of  
Spencer, Medina County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members  
concurring herein as follows:


**SECTION 1:** The salary of the Clerk/Treasurer of the  
Village of Spencer shall be payable monthly, effective  
November 1, 2001, as a yearly wage payable in the amount of Five  
Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$5,600.00).

**SECTION 2:** The salary of the Clerk/Treasurer of the  
Board of Public Affairs shall be payable monthly, effective  
November 1, 2001, as a yearly wage payable in the amount of Eight  
Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$8,400.00).


**SECTION 3:** The salary of the assistant to the  
Clerk/Treasurer of the Village of Spencer shall be payable  
monthly effective November 1, 2001, as a yearly wage payable in  
the amount of <sup>\$7,548.00</sup> ~~Five Thousand Five Hundred Forty-two Dollars~~  
(~~\$5,542.00~~) .

SECTION 4: The salary of the assistant to the Clerk/  
Treasurer of the Board of Public Affairs shall be payable  
monthly, effective November 1, 2001, as a yearly wage payable in  
the amount of <sup>\$11,867.00</sup> ~~Eight Thousand Three Hundred Fourteen Dollars~~  
(~~\$8,314.00~~) .

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public  
peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Spencer,  
Ohio, and for the particular reason that the salaries as adjusted  
and created above are necessary to effectuate the effective  
operation of the Spencer Village Government while a new person  
hired as the Clerk/Treasurer of the Village of Spencer and the  
Clerk/Treasurer of the Board of Public Affairs is trained with  
respect to the duties attendant to both government positions.
