

ORDINANCE NO. 7-01

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE
CLERK TO ACCEPT BIDS FOR PURCHASE OF
A DUMP TRUCK IN ACCORDANCE WITH
THE SPECIFICATIONS NOW ON FILE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, specifications for a truck that is needed by the Village of Spencer are hereby approved and filed in the office of the Clerk of this Council; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. That the Clerk of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of a truck that meets the requirements of specifications that are now filed in the office of the Clerk of this Council. The Village shall enter into a contract for said purchase with the lowest and best bidder.

2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village, and for the particular reason that it is necessary to purchase a truck that meets the specifications as outlined hereinabove so that Village

services may continue in an uninterrupted manner, and therefore,
this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage.
