

ORDINANCE NO. 15-02

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THAT THE IMPROVEMENT OF WATER MAINS AND APPURTENANCES IN MAIN AND CENTERVILLE STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER SHOULD BE MADE, ACCEPTING THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THE CONTRACT PRICE FROM THE APPROPRIATE FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Medina County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. That the improvement of water mains and appurtenances in Main and Centerville Streets in the Village of Spencer, Ohio, should be made in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council;

2. That the bid of Hanco Farms, Inc. in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-five Dollars (\$125,995.00) is hereby declared to be the lowest and best bid and is accepted by the Village of Spencer;


3. That the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the successful bidder on a contract form approved by the Village Solicitor;

4. That the contract price is hereby appropriate and shall be paid from the Firestone Fund and the appropriate street

improvement funds of the Village of Spencer in accordance with said contract.

This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village, and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to accept such bid and enter into a contract with a successful bidder in order to take advantage of the best and lowest bid and to commence work on the improvements as soon as practical during the current building season, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
