

**ORDINANCE NO. 5-02 ✓**

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT SPENCER  
VILLAGE PROPERTY OWNERS DISPLAY ADDRESS  
NUMBERS ON THEIR PROPERTY AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary to require owners of real property in the Village of Spencer to display an address number on their property so that emergency personnel may identify the properties as quickly as possible; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. Every owner, agent, or occupant of any property to which an address number has been assigned shall prominently display such number, each not less than three inches (3") in height, and in addition thereto, the number shall be visible from the curb. Said number shall be displayed on the structure in a conspicuous place, and in the case of new construction, shall be displayed at the time a final building inspection is requested.


2. No person shall deface any assigned number under the provisions of this Ordinance.

3. All violations of this Ordinance shall be corrected within a period of thirty (30) days after a written order is issued. Any violations not corrected within the specified period of time shall be prosecuted.


4. Whoever violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village and for the particular reason that it is necessary for property owners to have a visible address number so that the emergency personnel can locate the property as quickly as possible, and therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
