**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE
CLERK TO ACCEPT BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF A GAZEBO IN THE FIRESTONE PARK IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE SPECIFICATIONS
NOW ON FILE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, specifications, architectural, and engineering drawings for a gazebo that is to be constructed in the Spencer Village Firestone Park are hereby approved and filed in the office of the Clerk of this Council; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. That the Clerk of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of a gazebo in the Firestone Park in the Village of Spencer, Ohio, that meets the requirements of the specifications, architectural, and engineering drawings that are now filed in the office of the Clerk of this Council. The Village shall enter into a contract for construction of the gazebo with the lowest and best bidder.


2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village, and for the particular reason that it is necessary to obtain immediate bids for construction of the improvement during the current building

season, and therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
