

ORDINANCE NO. 5-03

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLACEMENT
OF STOP SIGNS ON WASHINGTON STREET**

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is necessary to stop traffic at the intersection of Washington Street and Jefferson Street within the territorial limits of the Village of Spencer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. A stop sign shall be placed on the north and south side of Washington Street at the intersection of Jefferson Street, thereby stopping eastbound and westbound traffic on Washington Street at the intersection of Jefferson Street.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Spencer and for the particular reason that traffic flow on Washington and Jefferson Streets needs to be stopped at the intersection of the two streets; this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
