

ORDINANCE NO. 4-07

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE MEDINA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR DISPATCHING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. That the Village of Spencer requires that the Medina County Sheriff's Office provide 24-hour-a-day, seven-day-a-week radio, telephone, and 9-1-1 emergency dispatching and communication services to the Village for the year 2007;

2. That the Mayor and the Village Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Medina County Sheriff's Office pursuant to the written Agreement for Dispatching Services attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A."

3. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to enter into a contract with the Medina County Sheriff's Department so that the Village is covered by emergency dispatch services, and that this

Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.


