ORDINANCE NO. 228

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT
FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION AND TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, This Council did duly adopt a
resolution declaring the necessity of constructing
certain designated sidewalk; and

WHEREAS the Village of Spencer has subsequently
constructed that portion of such sidewalk which was
not constructed by the owner of the property abutting
thereon; and

WHEREAS, a list of the estimated assessments of
the total cost of said construction has been prepared
and placed on file in the Office of the Clerk of this
Council; and

WHEREAS, there have been no objections filed
to the estimated assessment;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council
of the Village of Spencer,

1. That the list of estimated assessment for the
cost of constructing the sidewalk in front of Lot 49 in
Centerville Plat abutting north of Centerville Street,
commencing at Jackson Street and running westerly and
parallel with Centerville Street a distance of approx-
imately 65.3 feet to the east line of Lot 50 in Center-
ville Plat, said abutting land now standing the name of
Bonnie Jo Beliles, and all as heretofore reported
file in
to this Council and now on the Office of the Clerk of
this Council and aggregating in amount \$ 298 ⁵²/_{xx}
be and the same hereby is adopted and confirmed.

2. That the amounts of said assessment as aforesaid, be and the same hereby is assessed and levied upon the lot and land bounding and abutting upon said improvement.

3. That it is hereby determined that said assessment as aforesaid did not exceed the special benefits resulting from said improvement and does not exceed any statutory limitation.

4. That the Clerk of this Council be and he hereby is authorized and directed to continue on file in his office a list of said assessments, and the description of said lots and lands.

5. That the total assessment against said lot and parcel of land shall be payable in cash to the Treasurer of said Village within thirty days after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the property owner assessed, in five (5) annual installments with no interest thereon. The assessment and installments thereof which has not been paid at the expiration of said thirty day period shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor to be placed by him on the tax duplicate and collected at the same time and in the same manner as other taxes are collected, as provided by law.

6. That the Clerk of this Council be and he hereby is authorized and directed to cause notice of the passage of this ordinance to be published in the manner provided by law.

7. That the Clerk of this Council be and he hereby is authorized and directed to cause notice of the levy of the assessments herein provided for to be filed with the County Auditor within twenty (20) days following

the passage of this ordinance.

8. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer and for the special reason that it is necessary to immediately certify the assessment to the County Auditor if same is not paid within thirty (30) days, and this Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage.
