

ORDINANCE NO. 247

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALL OF THE FIFTEEN-FOOT ALLEYWAYS
IN BELLEVUE ADDITION WEST OF STATE STREET IN THE VILLAGE
OF SPENCER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Spencer,
who, three-fourths of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. Upon due consideration it is the opinion of the
Spencer Village Council that there is good cause for vacating
all of the fifteen-foot alleyways in the Bellevue Addition west
of State Street in the Village of Spencer and that such vacation
will not be detrimental to the general interest of the Village.

2. All of the fifteen-foot alleyways in the Bellevue
Addition, block A, B, C, west of State Street, (SR 301) in the
Village of Spencer are hereby vacated and title to the land of
such alleyways shall revert back to the successors in title of
the grantors who dedicated such alleyways. Such alleyways are
fully shown as the shaded areas in the attached plat which is
made a part hereof and are more particularly described as follows:

The alleyway east and west of Reed Street bounded on
the south by lots 8 through 16 of the Bellevue Addition,
Block A;

The alleyway east and west of Reed Street bounded on
the south by lots 13 through 24 and bounded on the
north by lots 25 through 36 of Bellevue Addition,
Block B;

The alleyway east and west of Reed Street bounded on
the north by lots 8 through 19 of Bellevue Addition,
Block C;

The alleyway running parallel to and between Reed Street
and State Street being bounded on the east by lots 1,
2, 3, and 4 of Block A of the Bellevue Addition and
lots 1 through 12 of Block B of the Bellevue Addition
and lots 1 through 7 of Block C of the Bellevue Addition
and being bounded on the west by lot 5 of Block A,
lot 36 and 13 of Block B and lot 8 of Block C of the
Bellevue Addition.

3. The Village Clerk shall cause a certified copy of
this Ordinance and the attached plat to be duly recorded in the
office of the Medina County Recorder.

4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,
safety, welfare of the Village of Spencer and this Ordinance shall
be in force and effect from and after its passage.
