

ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AGAINST BEING FOUND
INTOXICATED AND ASSESSING A PENALTY THEREFORE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village
of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring
herein, as follows:

1. No person shall be found in a state of
intoxication within the corporate limits of the Village
of Spencer, Ohio or, being intoxicated, shall disturb
the peace and good order of said Village, or shall con-
duct himself in a disorderly manner.

2. Whoever shall violate this ordinance shall
be fined not more than \$50.00.

3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health,
safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer and for the
particular reason that there is no effective prohibition
against public intoxication in the Village, and that this
Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and
after its passage.
