

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, PROHIBITING THE OUTSIDE STORAGE OF UNLICENSED MOTOR VEHICLES BY PERSONS, FIRMS OR CORPORATIONS OTHER THAN DEALERS IN MOTOR VEHICLES, GARAGES AND PAINT SHOPS AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the outside storage of unlicensed motor vehicles within the Village of Spencer, Medina County, Ohio by persons, firms or corporations other than dealers in motor vehicles, and operators and owners of garages and paint shops creates a condition which is deleterious, unsightly and harmful to property values,

AND, WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary for the protection of the public health, safety and general welfare of the Spencer Community that appropriate regulations be enacted governing the outside storage of such unlicensed motor vehicles,

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Spencer, as follows:

SECTION I: It shall be, and is hereby, unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to store, or permit to be stored, for a period of more than fifteen (15) days, a unlicensed motor vehicle upon any lot or land within the Village of Spencer unless the same shall be stored in a completely enclosed building or unless the same shall be stored by a dealer in motor vehicles, a garage or paint shop.

SECTION II: Any person, firm or corporation who violates the provision of ~~Section~~ Section I herein shall be deemed to have committed a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$25.00 for each violation and each day in which the violation shall continue after the permitted period shall be and constitutes a separate offense.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
