

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OUTSIDE STORAGE OF DISABLED OR JUNKED CARS IN THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER, ASSESSING A PENALTY THEREFOR AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of Council through complaints of the citizens that in certain areas of the village junked and disabled cars are being stored outside of any garage or enclosure to the detriment of adjoining property owners and the Village as a whole;

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Spencer, three- fourths of its members concurring herein as follows:

1. No person, firm, corporation or association shall store any disabled or junked vehicle or any unlicensed vehicle outside of any building within the Village of Spencer, Ohio for more than two weeks after such vehicle has become disabled, junked or unlicensed.

2. Whoever violates this Ordinance shall be fined not more than \$50.00. Each day of violation under this Ordinance shall be considered a separate offense.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Spencer and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to deter the proliferation in the Village of further disabled, junked or unlicensed vehicles, and that this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage.
