

RESOLUTION 12-96

A RESOLUTION INCREASING ESTIMATED REVENUES  
AND AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of  
Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths of its members concurring  
herein, as follows:

1. That estimated revenue for the General Fund be  
increased by \$23,761.00, and,
2. That budgeted appropriations for the General Fund be  
increased to \$79,876.00, and
3. That the Street Fund estimated revenue be increased by  
\$2,231.00, and,
4. That the Street Fund appropriations be increased by  
\$2,000.00, and,
5. That Debt Service Fund revenues be increased by  
\$25,714.00, and,
6. That Debt Service Fund appropriations be increased by  
\$25,714.00, and,
7. That the Sewer Fund revenues be increased by  
\$48,023.00, and,
8. That the Sewer Fund appropriations be amended by  
\$27,000.00, and that,

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,  
health, safety, and welfare in the Village of Spencer, Ohio  
and for the particular reason that funds cannot be spent if  
not properly appropriated and that this Resolution be in  
full force from and after its passage.
