

RESOLUTION NO. R-7 -97

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF  
THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE MEDINA  
COUNTY SAFETY TASK FORCE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, in the County of Medina, and State of Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Medina County Commissioners have established a County Wide Safety Communications Task force to review the current county communications system and to recommend changes and direction, and

WHEREAS, said Commission has participants representing all entities which do or may use the county's communications system, and

WHEREAS, after much deliberation the Task Force voted, with only one dissenting vote, that it was in the best interest of all those using the county communication system to at once increase the staffing and training for dispatchers, and

WHEREAS, the level of staffing agreed upon was 14.68 full-time equivalent employees, and

WHEREAS, the County was then asked to put a cost figure to the level of staffing and training agreed to and seek support from each entity utilizing the system as to its willingness to participate in the county communication system at such a level on a population basis, and


WHEREAS, the County has transmitted to the Village of Spencer what its share of said cost would be if set at such level, and

WHEREAS, it is seeking each participant's support to such staffing and training level prior to formally establishing such and sending out contracts, and


WHEREAS, it is understood the Medina County Safety Communications Task Force will continue to address the future needs and possible options to enhance our county wide communications system.

NOW COMES the Village of Spencer, and hereby supports the recommendations of the Medina County Safety Communications Task Force and will continue to participate in the County Communication System for the year of 1998 at the rate set forth in "Exhibit A."
