

RESOLUTION NO. R-3-97

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE ASSESSMENT
EQUALIZATION BOARD WITH RESPECT TO
THE ESTIMATED ASSESSMENTS FOR THE
LIBERTY STREET AND RAINBOW STREET
IMPROVEMENTS AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Council of the Village of Spencer to appoint an Assessment Equalization Board to hear and determine all objections with respect to the estimated assessments with regard to the improvements of Liberty Street and Jackson Street; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set a hearing date so that the Assessment Equalization Board may meet and hear all objections and submit its report and recommendations to the Village Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, in the County of Medina, and State of Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

1. That the members of the Assessment Equalization Board shall be Tina Hill, Don Vickers, and Walter Ziegler.


2. That the Assessment Equalization Board shall meet to hear all objections with respect to the estimated assessments with regard to the improvement of Liberty Street and ^{Rainbow} Jackson Street on May 13, 1997, at ^{6:00} 7:30 p.m. at the Spencer Village Hall.

3. That the Clerk of the Village of Spencer shall send notice to any land owner who has filed a written objection to the assessments for the improvements to Liberty Street and Rainbow Street by certified mail at least five (5) days prior to the date upon which the Equalization Board is to meet.

4. That the Assessment Equalization Board shall submit a report to the Village Council reporting a finding by a majority vote of the Equalization Board with respect to any objections to the assessments for improvements to Liberty Street and Rainbow Street.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and for the particular reason that it is immediately necessary to proceed with the proposed public improvement in order to accomplish the same in this building season and to obtain favorable bids for same, and that this Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
