

RESOLUTION NO. R-2 -98

A RESOLUTION IN CONNECTION WITH
THE VILLAGE OF SPENCER'S RESPONSIBILITY
FOR FALLEN TREE LIMBS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, in the County of Medina, and State of Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein, as follows:

That the Village of Spencer and/or its employees shall only be responsible for picking up tree limbs that have fallen from trees that are located in the tree lawn, if they have fallen as a result of storm damage. The Village of Spencer shall not be responsible for picking up tree limbs that have fallen from trees that are not located in the tree lawn.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of said Village for the reason that it is necessary to establish the Village of Spencer's responsibility with respect to fallen tree limbs, and therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
