

RESOLUTION R-23-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF SPACE IN THE SPENCER VILLAGE TOWN HALL FOR STORAGE OF FOOD CUPBOARD ITEMS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) of its members concurring herein as follows:


Section 1. Heather Davis is hereby authorized to utilize a large walk-in closet off of the Spencer Village Town Hall meeting room as a storage area for dry food items used as a part of a volunteer food cupboard. It is understood that operation of the food cupboard on Ms. Davis's part and on the part of other persons working with the food cupboard is done on a voluntary basis and is not associated with duties attributable to employment with the Village of Spencer. The Village of Spencer is not authorizing or accepting legal responsibility for actions or inactions associated with operation of the food cupboard. This Resolution is limited to strictly authorizing the use of space for storage of dry goods used as a part of the food cupboard operation.

Section 2. This Resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Spencer, Ohio, and for the particular reason that storage space is immediately necessary for dry food goods that are being made available to persons through the food cupboard overseen and managed by Heather Davis; this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.
