Child Health/Development:

If a child requires emergency medical care and the parent or emergency contact cannot be located the Director, Assistant to the Director, or teacher has the authority to contact 911 (initial)
No staff member at MHCP is permitted to administer medication of any kind to a student(initial)
If an EPI pen is prescribed by a physician, the EPI pen will be kept in the office closet with the child's name and expiration date noted on the zip lock bag. Upon giving an EPI pen to a child, 911 will be called by the school administrator (initial)
