Benefits of St. Paul's Memorial Society

A deceased person's name is inscribed in our Book of Remembrance which rests in an oak case beneath the 14th station of the cross in St. Paul's Church. The 14th station of the cross reminds us of Jesus disciples placing His body in the tomb on the First Good Friday afternoon!

The window next to our shrine of remembrance is that of our Blessed Mother holding the lifeless body of Jesus in her lap, the Pieta.

The Book of Remembrance contains all the days of the calendar year. The names of the deceased enrolled in the Memorial Society appear according to the day of the year on which the person passed.

Above our Shrine of Remembrance, there appears this brief message. "Let Us Pray For Those Who Have Died This Day" Everyday as worshipers pass the Shrine, they will see the names of those who left this world on that particular day. Additionally, all of the members of the Memorial Society will be remembered in a special mass on the First Friday of every month throughout the year. The list of names for the month are also including in our parish monthly insert in our bulletin.

Enrollment donation into the Memorial Society is a \$100.00. Or once \$100.00 dollars or more is reached in Memorial Fund in donations they will be enrolled automatically. Year after year your loved one will be remembered on the First Friday of the month, during the month of their passing.
