The Tenebrae service is a powerful and moving service celebrated during Holy Week. The name, Tenebrae, means "darkness" in Latin, reflecting the solemn mood as we remember the suffering and death of Jesus. During this service, candles are gradually extinguished, leaving the church in near darkness, symbolizing the sorrow and abandonment Jesus experienced. The service includes scripture readings, psalms, and silent reflection.

The Tenebrae service invites the faithful to meditate deeply on the death of Christ and enter into the solemn mystery of Holy Week.


