FATHER JOHN'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF ORDINATION CELEBRATION

MASS REQUESTS ~ Just a little reminder about Mass requests. Please get them in as soon as possible. **Most of the time, people know when they would like a Mass said for someone, especially if it's an anniversary of death, a birthday, etc.** So, please do not wait until a week before you would like the Mass said. It might not be able to be said on the day you would like it. Also, you may put more than one name on the Mass request sheet, however, only one name can be listed for each Mass request for a specific day and the payment must be for each Mass that will be said for that particular person.

As we are linked with St. Paul's, they are trying to get us on the same schedule as they are on.
